Gather, Give, Grow and Go with God!




Growing up, we always watched *A Christmas Carol*, along with many other favorite Christmas movies and shows. My favorite version starred George C. Scott as Ebenezer Scrooge. So, I was especially excited to discover this year's Advent series entitled *The Redemption of Scrooge*. *A Christmas Carol* has always been one of my favorites possibly because it feels strikingly relevant to our lives.

As we move into the busier weeks ahead, I often wonder what we miss when we get swept up in the busyness and consumerism of the season. Do we really take time to slow down and reflect on the year? I know I often find myself reminiscing about Christmases past, wondering about Christmases still to come—even this one—and looking forward to the moments that await us on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day.

I first remember seeing George C. Scott in the movie *Patton*, for which he won the Academy Award for Best Actor. In the film, Scott portrayed General George S. Patton, a controversial World War II hero—a deeply flawed man, much like his later portrayal of Scrooge. I've often wondered why Scott played such characters with such authenticity. In digging deeper, I learned that Scott was a member of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church in Hecktown, Pennsylvania. I suspect that Scott brought a certain personal vulnerability to the characters he portrayed. Perhaps, grounded in his faith, he understood how easily we rely on ourselves rather than remembering that we are the body of Christ and what God has done for us in Jesus. If you've seen both films, you may understand what I mean.

All this to say, I am truly excited to take a deep dive into scripture this Advent through the lens of one of the most beloved Christmas stories of all time. We'll journey with Scrooge and hear Jesus' reminder of what was, what is, and what is to come. We will be reminded of God's promises and hold tightly to them as we move toward a future we have not yet lived.

Jesus' incarnation was—and still is—the hope of the world. We need only live into the peace, hope, love, and joy that came down from heaven, was born into meager means, and walked alongside those whom the world cast aside. What a joy it is to hear God's good news proclaimed to all!

I look forward to celebrating this season with you!




