

Gather, Give, Grow and Go with God!




Ash Wednesday is just over two weeks away, and Lent is nearly upon us. Time seems to rush past, or maybe we're just too busy to notice the Spirit at work in our lives.

This Lent, we'll walk through the Lord's Prayer, petition by petition, remembering how these words echo the promises made at our baptism and affirmed in confirmation. Each week invites us to reflect on what it means to live differently than the world would have us live—a life shaped by love, humility, and justice.

This Lenten season we will have worship at 6:30pm on Ash Wednesday and following weekly midweek Lenten Services with dinner at 5:45pm, worship at 6:30pm with Holden Evening Prayer. We will be welcoming other Pastors from area churches to share the message every Wednesday. Our midweek series is titled *Jesus: Pro or Con?* We will be wrestling with the gospel and the cost of discipleship in light of how we are called by the Spirit to live out our baptismal promises.



Lent reminds us that following Jesus means living differently than the world often expects. The life Jesus lived challenged the powers of empire and the assumptions of religious leaders, not through force, but through love, justice and self-giving grace. This is the way of life to which we are called as disciples and apostles.

For many of us, the lessons of Confirmation may feel distant, yet the promises made in those moments continue to shape who we are and how we live. During this Lenten season, our Sunday worship will return to the Lord's Prayer, reflecting on each petition as a guide for faithful living. As we pray together, we are invited to listen again to Jesus' words, to remember what we have been taught, and to relearn how this prayer forms us as a community. In praying the Lord's Prayer, we discover not only familiar words, but a shared calling to live our faith together.

Lent is a season to pause, to listen, and to open ourselves to God's grace. May this season guide us to slow down, pray more deeply, and live our faith with courage and hope, knowing we do not walk this journey alone.

March 1: **Hallowed Be Thy Name** – Proclaim Christ through word and deed


March 8: **Thy Kingdom Come** – Serve all people, following the example of Jesus



WHO CAN RIDE?

As a part of our partnership, transportation is available to all Oconto County Residents. Vehicles are ADA compliant and equipped with wheelchair lifts.

COST?

Fares or mileage reimbursement are requested for rides. Reduced fares are available to residents age 55+ as well as individuals with disabilities.

NEEDS?

This transportation service is provided for individuals who need rides for medical appointments, nutritional needs (groceries), social or recreational purposes, and personal business.
