

Appointment with Disappointment

God is there for us in the disappointing times



➤ Prayer Time:

Begin with this prayer.

"Lord, we know that life brings both joy and disappointment. When life brings disappointment, we often forget that you are still in charge of this world. Help us remember that you really are in charge, that you can use disappointment to teach us how to live the Christian life. Amen"

➤ Warm Up Time:

Complete this sentence: Disappointments happen to people because . . .

➤ Talk Time:

Do you think you would be disappointed if you got everything you wanted?
When things don't go your way, how do you usually react?
What is the difference between regret and disappointment? *
How does God work in our disappointments?

* **Regret** is often the feeling of sadness or remorse we feel about something we did or did not do.
Disappointment involves something we did not get.

➤ Bible Time:

God tells us in Ecclesiastes 3 (CEV) that
"Everything on earth has its own time and its own season. There is a time . . . for crying and laughing, weeping and dancing." We are assured that, though it always doesn't make sense, "God makes everything happen at the right time. Yet none of us can ever fully understand all he has done. . . ."

If God is in charge, how should we handle disappointment? First, remember that God is in control. Second, realize our feelings of disappointment are part of life. It's OK to feel them! Third, give our disappointments to God even as we gratefully give thanks for all God has done for us. And fourth, understand that God uses our disappointments to teach us how to trust more deeply in a loving, caring God.

➤ Action Time:

How does being a follower of Christ help us respond differently to disappointment? How would Jesus Christ want you to respond to a bad game? A friendship that ends? A boyfriend/girlfriend breakup? A setback at work?

"You have looked deep into my heart, Lord, and you know all about me. You know when I am resting or when I am working, and from heaven you discover my thoughts. You notice everything I do and everywhere I go. Before I even speak a word, you know what I will say, and with your powerful arm you protect me from every side. I can't understand all of this! Such wonderful knowledge is far above me." Psalm 139:1-6 (CEV)

The summer after a wealthy young summer guest dies under suspicious circumstances, her best friend lives under a cloud of grief and suspicion.

Littleport, Maine, has always felt like two separate towns: an ideal vacation enclave for the wealthy, whose summer homes line the coastline; and a simple harbor community for the year-round residents whose livelihoods rely on service to the visitors.

Typically, fierce friendships never develop between a local and a summer girl—but that's just what happens with visitor Sadie Loman and Littleport resident Avery Greer. Each summer for almost a decade, the girls are inseparable—until Sadie is found dead. While the police rule the death a suicide, Avery can't help but feel there are those in the community, including a local detective and Sadie's brother, Parker, who blame her. Someone knows more than they're saying, and Avery is intent on clearing her name, before the facts get twisted against her.

The Last House Guest is a smart, twisty read that brilliantly explores the elusive nature of memory and the complexities of female friendships.

Home-Canned Items Needed For Fall Bazaar

The canning season is here, which means the bazaar is not that far away! The Canned Goods area is a popular stop for the Bazaar shoppers. Needed canned goods are jams, jellies, pickles, fruit sauces, salsa and anything else that can be canned safely. When you're canning, if you can set aside a dozen (or more!) for the Bazaar, it would be appreciated.


Between 50-60 dozen are needed.

To keep the product consistent and safe, here are a few guidelines:

- Use standard canning jars: 8 oz. for jams and jellies, pint and quart for pickles, etc. (brand unimportant).
- Seal with ring/lid (brand unimportant).
- Jars should be filled, i.e., no gap from top of product to bottom of ring.
- Jams, jellies, preserves, etc. should be soft set (jiggles like Jello) or firm set (no jiggle). That pesky batch that didn't set can always be sold as a topping!

For product safety use FDA water bath processing guidelines.

The Bazaar canners recycle: empty jars and rings in good condition can be used over and over and help keep costs down. Bring them to church during August and September and the canners will fill them up again.
