Managing God's Gifts To Us

Enough Discovering Joy Through Simplicity and Generosity

One of Jesus' great teaching parables involves a sower who cast seed along the ground. The sower hoped the seeds would sprout, grow, and bear good fruit. Some seeds did just that, producing a great harvest. But others, Jesus said, fell among thorns and, though they began to grow, these good plants were quickly choked out. Jesus said the thorns were "the cares of the world and the lure of wealth" (Matthew 13:22).

In a culture where having "enough" seems to have become a never-ending pursuit, Jesus' parable remains incredibly relevant. Many of us are chasing the American dream in ways that lead to stress, anxiety, and fear—thorns that can rob us of the ability to enjoy the abundant lives of purpose that God intended for us.

All of us have struggled with these issues at one time or another. They are important issues that we cannot ignore. This is why, over the course of five weeks, starting in October, we will be having a churchwide study and worship emphasis called *Enough: Discovering Joy Through Simplicity and Generosity*. During this time, we will explore what the Bible teaches us about financial management through worship and conversations. We'll hear advice and stories about what others have learned by working through financial challenges. Each week we will provide you with some practical tools you can use to assess your financial situation and develop a financial plan with a biblical foundation.

At the conclusion of the emphasis, we will have the opportunity to make personal commitments of our offerings to God through our church in the coming year. We will consecrate these commitments in the worship service Sunday, November 3, 2024. (See the schedule that follows.)

We hope you will join us in the coming weeks as we look at how we can manage our financial resources and truly experience simplicity, generosity, and joy.





Make Mealtime Family Time

Great for every family! Lots of creative ways for families to talk, share, and play together.



For families with kids from two years of age and up. Parents, please paraphrase and modify to meet the age-appropriate needs and attitudes of your family.

Welcome to a shared mealtime where your family records memories and faith milestones, writes prayer requests, doodles, and plays games on a blank tablecloth. No phone required!

- Cover your mealtime table with a simple plastic tablecloth, purchased inexpensively at a party supply store or online, along with some markers and crayons (permanent markers work best).
- While eating your meal, hand out crayons or permanent markers. If you are worried about marks ending up on your table, cover your table with newspaper or other covering before you lay out the tablecloth.
- Ask your family members to express themselves with drawings, poems, prayers, and memories on the tablecloth. Play games like Tic-Tac-Toe. Doodle to your heart's content.
- Record faith milestones from the past year—such as baptisms, first Bible, learning the Ten Commandments and the Apostle's Creed, first communion, confirmation, and other faith markers.
- All that you record can be talked about during family meals over the next couple of weeks. Here are ideas you might consider:

Home-Canned Items Needed For Fall Bazaar

The canning season is here, which means the bazaar is not that far away! The Canned Goods area is a popular stop for the Bazaar shoppers. Needed canned goods are jams, jellies, pickles, fruit sauces, salsa and anything else that can be canned safely. When you're canning, if you can set aside a dozen (or more!) for the Bazaar, it would be appreciated.

Between 50-60 dozen are needed.

To keep the product consistent and safe, here are a few guidelines:

- Use standard canning jars: 8 oz. for jams and jellies, pint and quart for pickles, etc. (brand unimportant).
- Seal with ring/lid (brand unimportant).
- Jars should be filled, i.e., no gap from top of product to bottom of ring.
- Jams, jellies, preserves, etc. should be soft set (jiggles like Jello) or firm set (no jiggle). That pesky batch that didn't set can always be sold as a topping!

For product safety use FDA water bath processing guidelines.

The Bazaar canners recycle: empty jars and rings in good condition can be used over and over and help keep costs down. Bring them to church during August and September and the canners will fill them up again.
