Have You Opened the Book of Proverbs Lately?

Did you know that the Book of Proverbs is a collection of writings traditionally attributed to King Solomon—along with Ecclesiastes and the Song of Solomon? While Solomon's name is traditionally connected to these works, Proverbs was likely compiled by court and temple sages—counselors, bureaucrats, and teachers of the time. These wise sayings were edited between the 5th and 3rd centuries BCE with one goal: to teach wisdom—God's wisdom.

My child, if you accept my words and treasure up my commandments within you, making your ear attentive to wisdom and inclining your heart to understanding,

if you indeed cry out for insight and raise your voice for understanding, if you seek it like silver and search for it as for hidden treasures— then you will understand the fear of the LORD and find the knowledge of God. Proverbs 2:1-5

I often hear people say, "I can be with God in nature; I don't need to come to church." And while it's true that you can experience God's presence in the beauty of creation, I ask: How are you hearing God's Word if you're not gathering with the Body of Christ? Part of being a disciple of Jesus is regularly hearing and reflecting on God's Word—something many of us do together on Sunday mornings.

Yes—summer is coming! I, too, look forward to the freedom and joy the season brings: camping trips, outdoor concerts and festivals, Breakfast on the Farm, gardening, and so much more in these sun-filled months. But in the midst of all the activity, how are you caring for your heart and soul? Are you growing in your understanding of who God is? Are you staying connected to your calling as the hands and feet of Jesus in the world?

As our weekly Club 9 (Confirmation) sessions wrapped up this week, I was reminded that I might not see many of our students over the summer. So I encouraged them—and now I encourage you—to stay connected to your faith. We've been studying Luther's Small Catechism, and each session ends with Luther's Evening Blessing. I've encouraged our students and families to make this—or Luther's Morning Blessing—part of their daily rhythm. Even something as simple as starting the day with the Lord's Prayer can become a meaningful "mini worship" moment. God longs to hear from you!

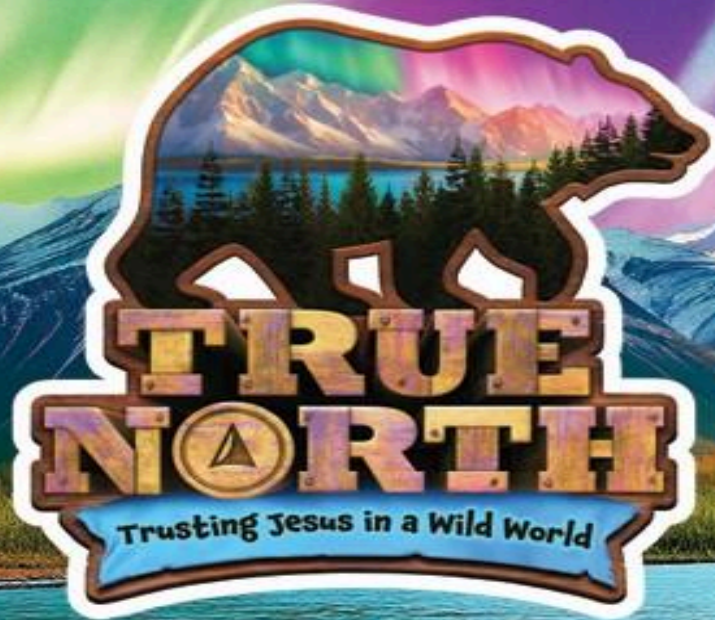
