Gather, Give, Grow and Go with God!





Alleluia! Christ Is Risen! He Is Risen Indeed! Alleluia!

Last weekend we heard the story of who we have deemed, the “doubting” Thomas. The disciple of Jesus who missed his first appearance to the disciples but then wanted to physically experience, actually touch, Jesus’ wounds before he believed what he was seeing. I shared how Jesus and Thomas had something in common, in how they both came back. Jesus could have been rejected by the disciples when he came back BUT HE CAME BACK! We are not sure why Thomas left the other disciples in the first place, BUT HE CAME BACK!

I think one of the most important verses in John is “*Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of this disciples that are not written in this book.*” Did John run out of stamina to write them all down or was this intentional? “*But these are written so that you may continue to believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that through believing you may have life in his name.*”

I do not believe that we need to have every single miracle or parable written out so that we might believe this miraculous story of Resurrection, of New Life! We know there were numerous times Jesus performed miracles and yet turned to the eyewitnesses and instructed them not to share what they had experienced, BUT THEY KEPT COMING BACK!

As the council begins coffee conversations this month, I pray you KEEP COMING BACK for those conversations. The council is eager to share what they are working on and to hear from the congregation in these conversations. This is important work as we look to the future of St. John’s and how we do ministry together and for the community of Little Suamico. And even though you may not serve on the council, you do have some work to do to help your council.

The church, worldwide, is in great change and our council is responding to that. When Jesus died, change happened. When Jesus rose again, change happened. When Jesus appeared to his disciples, in the upper room, change happened. Jesus’ ministry changed and our ministry is changing. With change can come grief, as it did for the disciples, and it will come for us too as we look at changing how we do ministry in our building and in the world.

The disciples faced persecution as they did the work Jesus started and commended to his disciples to continue, and that includes us, today! “*As the Father has sent me, so I send you.*” Jesus is calling and sending us, once again, to do the work he started. That work starts with our relationships with one another in these Coffee Conversations. In the months ahead, I encourage you to participate in the conversations AND I challenge you to find a ministry, at St. John’s, that you can be part of. We all have different talents and gifts and each of us is called to use and share them with the body of Christ.

PLEASE, KEEP COMING BACK, just as Thomas did! PLEASE, keep listening to one another. PLEASE keep listening to how God and the Holy Spirit are calling you into participation in the ministry of St. John’s and in the world. Martin Luther reminds us we are *the priesthood of all believers* and the beauty of the Lutheran church is there are a variety of ministries that the congregation is called to be part of. If you are not sure what that gift is, I would love to have a conversation to help draw that out.

We all have doubted, just as Thomas did, about how we fit into the ministry we are called to BUT WE KEEP COMING BACK to hear what Jesus has in store for the body of Christ.

Dear People of St. John’s... KEEP COMING BACK!

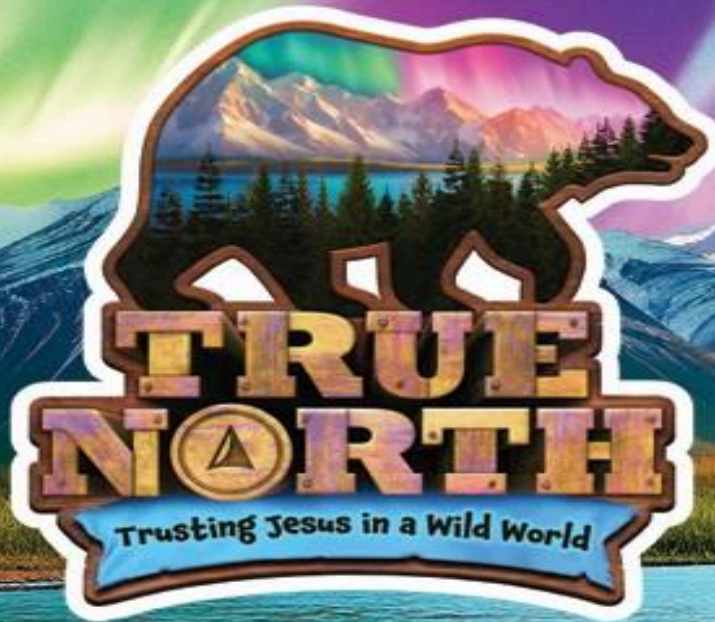

Crayon PRAYERS

For families with kids from two years of age and up. Parents, please paraphrase and modify to meet the age-appropriate needs, attitudes, and safety concerns of your family. Younger children can watch parents enjoying this activity to model healthy family life.

Saying prayers in color

What You'll Need: Box of crayons, paper

Say the word "prayer" and some people feel a sense of quiet and calm. This is good but prayer can also be a time of celebration, an explosion of color.

- #1 Say to your child something like, "Let's say a prayer in color."
- #2 From a box of crayons have your child choose her absolute favorite colors.
- #3 Talk with your child about what or who she would like to pray for. Prayers could be about grandparents, pets, friends or fears.
- #4 Using the colors she picked and a sheet of paper help express her prayers in an explosion of color in either words or pictures. You can also color a prayer.

#5 Pray with your child something like, "Dear Jesus, these colors show how my prayers 'feel' and look. Thank you for listening to them. Amen"

#6 Coloring isn't just for little ones. Older children and teenagers will do *Crayon Prayers* if you ask them to do it with you as a way to express their prayers.

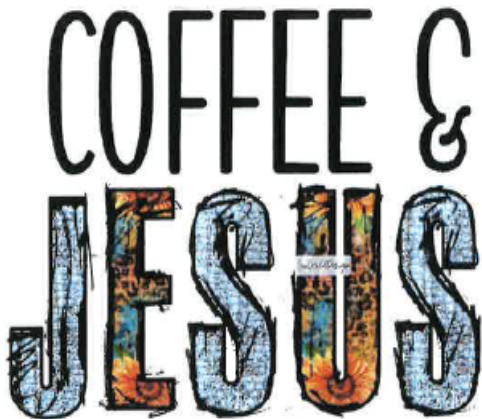

Sheena's Story: Homelessness to Homeownership

Three years ago, Sheena entered Freedom House with her children after going through a divorce and finding herself unable to get approved to rent a place on her own. She was connected with EPH after a few months and entered the EPH transitional housing program. Sheena was matched with a case manager upon moving into an EPH home to support her on her journey to self-sufficiency. Families in the transitional housing program meet with a case manager weekly and focus on goals related to family well-being, financial stability, housing security, employment, education, and home care. In less than a year, Sheena was ready to take the next step. She was accepted into the long-term supportive housing program and began renting a house owned by EPH. Families in this program continue to meet with a case manager regularly while working on their goals and building a positive rental history. During her time with EPH, Sheena maintained stable employment, participated in budget counseling, paid off debt, and built savings. Determined to become a homeowner, she applied to the Habitat for Humanity homeownership program and received approval to purchase a house through this program soon afterwards. Over the past few years, Sheena worked tirelessly to not only build a stable future for her family but also help build her new house alongside many amazing volunteers. In December 2024 – just three years after entering a shelter with her children - all her hard work paid off as she became a homeowner and celebrated Christmas in her new house! When asked what she would tell other mothers entering our program, she said, "At times, it may seem tough, but eventually it gets better. It's a good program to be in. I learned a lot related to budgeting. You can talk to a worker about anything, and they will help you find resources." The EPH team feels blessed to have walked alongside Sheena on her journey. We know she will be successful in this next chapter of her life and we wish her all the best. Thank you for supporting EPH and helping make Sheena's homeownership dream a reality!

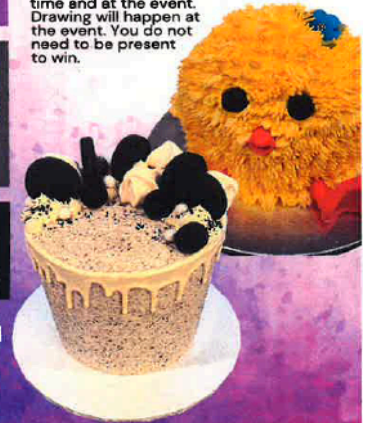

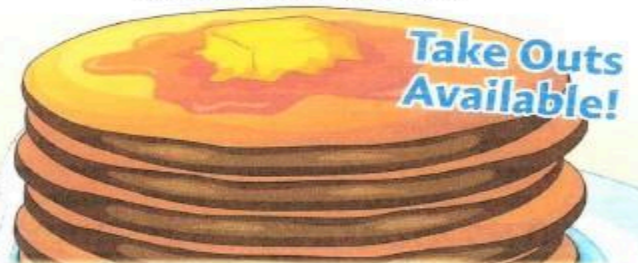
