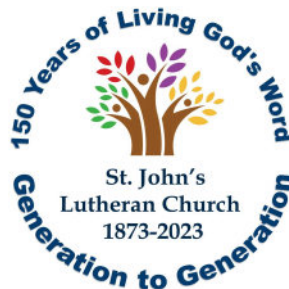

Dear Church,

Tis the Season! Which season, you ask? Summer? No. Construction season? Always, but not what I mean here. Brewers season? Possibly... I am of course talking about Budget Season here at the church. We do indeed start the budget process this early for the following year. By the time you read this, our treasurer is preparing a spreadsheet for the council and individual teams to review in September.

The general flow goes something like this: the church council sends out budget requests to the different groups that represent St. John's (ie Outreach, Buildings and Grounds, etc). Once they have a chance to meet and deliberate, they pass their numbers along to the Stewardship Team (ST).

ST breaks it down section by section asking questions and looking for the rationale behind the dollars being requested. ST will reach out to the different groups if clarifications or adjustments are needed. Next a rough draft will be presented to Council to add their questions, comments, and concerns. There may be a couple rounds of going back and forth, but eventually the 2026 Budget will get recommended by the ST, approved by Council and then presented to the congregation for their vote in January.

Figuring out our church budget is a little different than doing a budget for your household. For most families, figuring out your income for 2026 is pretty straightforward. If you have a salary, maybe it is as simple as factoring in a raise. If you get paid hourly, you just need to multiply that figure by how many hours you think you'll work next year. Computing the income for St. John's isn't so simple.

Donations ebb and flow throughout the year and no two years are alike. We base our numbers off of previous years' totals, but must factor in how attendance is doing as well as the overall economy. We will always do our best to lean toward a lower number and hope we exceed it.

Most of our expenses are your typical increases based on inflation or notifications from utilities. Payroll ends up right around where it is projected. Other items, specifically upkeep on the building, are a lot tougher to predict. We learned a year ago how much work it is to keep the building functional and constantly improving while trying to stay within our means. You never know when an HVAC unit (or multiple) will need replacing or a leak will start in the roof. Thank you to Buildings and Grounds for staying on top of these things.

That is a little behind the scenes look at how the budget goes from a bunch of projections to a final product that you get to discuss and vote on in January.

A special thank you, in advance, to all the groups for getting your numbers in so quickly this year, for ST and council to have time to decipher them. We have some good people doing great things! If you have a fancy for numbers and stewardship, we would love to have you join the Stewardship Team. Contact Sara Beth Holman or myself.

We ask you, also, to prayerfully begin considering your giving for the upcoming year. We are called to be cheerful givers of our time, talents, and gifts. St. John's offers many different opportunities for this. If you wonder about where the Spirit is calling you to contribute, consider a prayerful conversation with others or with myself. This is the least talked about topic in all churches but it is a very important one. I look forward to our conversations.

"Give Them Roots and Create Wings"

With summer (and the midpoint of the year) upon us, I would like to take a moment to thank you – our supporters - and share the impact your generosity has made so far this year.

This past year, St. John's Lutheran Little Suamico directly helped three families in need, on two different properties in providing safe, reliable housing. The efforts of each team that helped with the cleaning, decorating, and preparing of each of the homes is greatly appreciated. Since the new year, each family has found stability and is doing well under the EPH wing.

Additionally, each night, approximately 100 children fall asleep in an EPH home. Your support is providing them with more than just a temporary home – it's giving them safety, stability, and the opportunity for a brighter future.

Five children living in EPH homes graduated from high school this year, and two have been accepted into college programs. With your support, we have provided housing and case management for 44 families – including 114 children – so far this year. The families we've served this year have made great strides, including becoming debt-free, earning promotions, furthering their education, and taking the steps necessary for long-term stability. We helped one of these families transition from homelessness to homeownership when they purchased the home they were living in from EPH. Another family applied, was accepted, built, and moved into a home from Habitat for Humanity.

Thank you for helping make their dreams a reality!

As we look forward to the second half of the year, we are excited about what lies ahead. We will run and promote our fundraising 'mail campaign' to further assist families in 2025 and beyond. We will have our second annual Grace & Gratitude Gathering – a casual evening to raise awareness for our mission. We hope you will save the date and join us on November 20th at Stadium View. And, we will turn our home over, (cleaning and decorating for a new family) towards the end of the year as the current family moves on within our programming and from the Transitional Housing phase.

Thank you for being part of this mission. Your generosity and compassion are making it possible for families to find safety, stability, and hope. May God bless you for the love you've poured into the families we serve at EPH.

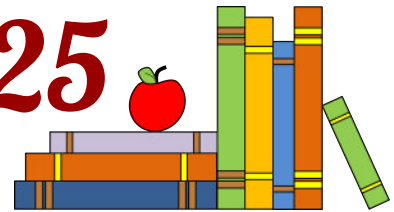

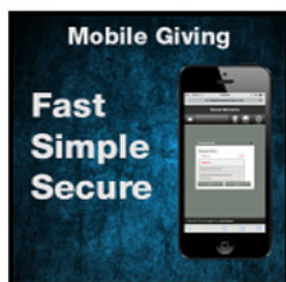
