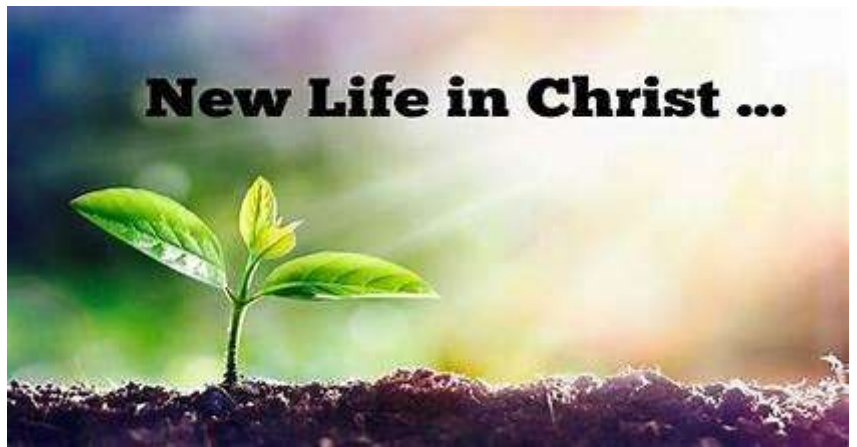


He Is Risen! Alleluia!

In just a few short days we will be shouting this to the rooftops of our church! I encourage you to take that good news and shout it to the heavens as you go on your way!

Just a couple of weeks ago we experienced the second “worst” snowstorm of our state’s history. In some yards, prior to this storm, spring had already sprung with flowers splitting through the sleeping winter dirt. I wondered how they would fare with the impending weather. It wasn’t clear how cold it might be or just how much snow we were going to get. Well, the snow covered more than just those beautiful buds.

Every spring, it amazes me how the early flowers endure the harsh cold and snow, but then Easter comes. We often forget that Easter does not end with the resurrection. In the church we celebrate 50 days of Easter! Seven weeks plus one day of celebrating the new creation we are because of the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. On that 50<sup>th</sup> day there is another celebration, Pentecost, the descending of the Spirit upon Jesus’ people, that includes you and me.



But, every Sunday is a celebration! A day of the week we come together, as a community of faith, to shout Alleluias, sing praises, pray, and offer our thanksgiving for the wonderful thing God has done in Jesus for all of creation, including those tender little buds in our gardens.

With that in mind, I encourage you to find moments everyday to celebrate what Jesus has done. In the Lenten season many of us “give up something”, but it’s not really about giving something up! It’s about making space to build on your tender relationship with God. Making space in the mire of every day life to live into the new creation you have become in the waters of baptism.

As the earth awakens, as the days grow longer and warmer, as you plant your seeds, as you watch new growth break through the earth, reflect on the new creation before you and in you because of God’s great love for us sent in his Son, Jesus Christ!

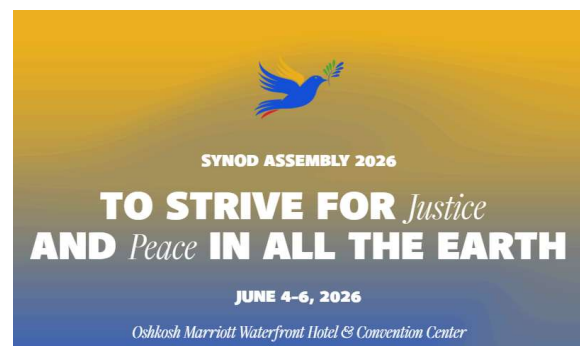

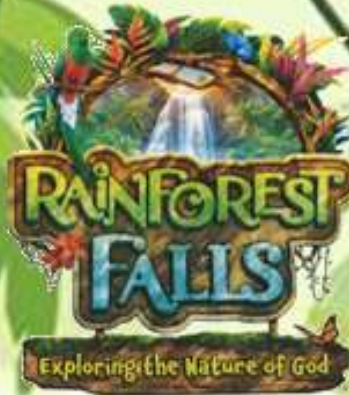

## Gratitude & Growth: A Look Back at 2025

With spring upon us, I would like to take a moment to thank you – our supporters - and share the impact your generosity has made in the past year.

St. John's Lutheran Little Suamico directly helped several families in need, on two different properties in providing safe, reliable housing. The efforts of each team that helped with the cleaning, decorating, and preparing of each of the homes is greatly appreciated. Each family has found stability and is doing well under the EPH wing.

Each night, approximately 100 children fall asleep in an EPH home. Your support is providing them with more than just a temporary home – it's giving them safety, stability, and the opportunity for a brighter future.

With your support, EPH provided housing and case management for 62 families, including 156 children, in 2025. Prevention Services were provided to 66 families who were saved from eviction, including 138 children. In 2025, 128 families (294 children) were served. The families we've served have made great strides, including becoming debt-free, earning promotions, furthering their education, and taking the steps necessary for long-term stability.

Thank you for helping make their dreams a reality!

As we look forward to the year ahead, we will run and promote our fundraising 'mail campaign' later this month to further assist families in 2026 and beyond. We will also have our third annual Grace & Gratitude Gathering – a casual evening to raise awareness for our mission. We hope you will save the date and join us in November at Stadium View Event Halls. This is tentatively scheduled for November 5th, pending the Packers schedule release.

Thank you for being part of this mission. Your generosity and compassion are making it possible for families to find safety, stability, and hope. May God bless you for the love you've poured into the families we serve at EPH.
